- Third, you would review and expand upon the guiding questions we have already prepared for each story, to stretch children's comprehension, imagination, empathy, and neural development.

Your mission is to ensure that the Chinese language content that we help children access is linguistically precise, culturally resonant, and phonetically accurate.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Linguistic Audit (QC):** Verify Hanzi and Pinyin accuracy in our backend system, ensuring the digital text is flawless and matches our master scripts before production begins.
- **Voice Narration:** Record native level, high-quality, expressive audio narrations with perfect tonal clarity that bring characters and stories to life for young listeners.
- **Pedagogical Design:** Craft helpful "Guiding Questions" per book (Literal, Inferential, and Applied) to foster deep parent-child engagement and help develop critical thinking and empathy in children.
- **Metadata Management:** Categorize books by age level, theme, and language difficulty to power our recommendation engine.
